Keep receiving areas, loading docks and warehouses sanitary, warm, dry and safe



### Prevents Heat from Escaping and Cold Drafts

Creates a strong environmental separation and prevent harsh outside temperatures and drafts from entering the facility to keep workers productive and comfortable.



### Saves Energy and Saves You Money

Lightens the load on your current HVAC system and lowers your heating and cooling costs by blocking outside air penetration.



### Increases Safety and Minimizes Humidity

Keeps your workers safe and slip-free by preventing rain, ice, snow, moisture and condensation build-up on the floor with a durable brush seal that will not deteriorate from cold Canadian winters.



### Keeps Contaminants Out

Prevents contaminants such as dust, insects and rodents from entering the facility. Mice and other rodents dislike the texture of the brush, it deters them from chewing on the brush and from entering your facility through the receiving doors.



### Blocks White Light to Pass Audits

During audits, the first thing auditors look for is white light infiltration as insects and pests are attracted to interior lights, odours and warm indoor temperatures. Brush weather seals creates a strong seal at the bottom of doors and in cracks, even if workers do not properly close the door.
